

Attempted Abduction

On 01/17/2012 an attempted abduction was reported to our agency. The victim was a 12 year old female who reported that she was waiting at her bus stop when she observed a white Chevrolet cargo van approach the stop sign at her bus stop. The victim advised that the van conducted a u-turn in the intersection and pulled up to her with left wheels to the curb. The victim advised that the driver told her "Get in the van". The victim told the driver no and the driver said again in a more stern voice , Get in the van . The victim advised that she became very scared and ran across the street away from the van. The victim advised that the van conducted another u-turn and left the area.

The victim advised that there were two male Hispanics in the van. The victim described the driver as being 20-30 years of age with brown hair and brown eyes and spoke with an accent. The driver was reported to have a tear drop tattoo on his left cheek. The driver was described as wearing a purple hooded sweatshirt with a crown on the front and the letter K under the crown and black pants with a white stripe down the leg.

The passenger was described as 20-30 years of age, bald with a goatee and blue eyes. The passenger was reported to be wearing the same hooded sweatshirt as the driver with the crown and letter K on the front. The passenger was also reported to have a tear drop tattoo on his right cheek. The victim reported seeing the passenger loading a hand gun while seated in the passenger seat of the van.

The van was described as being a mid to late 90 s Chevrolet cargo van with no windows other than those on the driver and passenger doors. The victim advised that the van had no major damage or markings, however the van did have some rust on the rear passenger side cargo door and slight damage to the front bumper. The victim advised that the license plate was an Illinois passenger plate starting with A38, remainder unknown.
