BOARD RECOGNIZES TEAMS



The Board recognized three Huntley 158 teams that recently capped successful seasons with strong finishes in state competition. The Heineman Middle School 7th Grade Boys Basketball Team took 4th at the Class 4A IESA State Tournament

Series; the Huntley High School Varsity Poms team earned 8th place at the IHSA state competition; and the Huntley High School Varsity Wrestling earned 4th place at the IHSA state competition.

HUNTLEY 158 JOINS FIVE OTHER DISTRICTS FOR REGIONALIZED SPECIAL ED SERVICES

The Board approved an intergovernmental agreement with five other area districts to create regionalized programming to provide a comprehensive continuum of services for special needs students that live within the respective boundary areas of each district.

The participating districts are Huntley 158, Fox River Grove District 3, Cary District 26, Prairie Grove District 46, Crystal Lake Elementary District 47, and Community High School District 155.

The Board also approved the withdrawal of the District from the Special Education District of McHenry County (SEDOM), effective July 1, 2018.

The five other participating districts also will be withdrawing from SEDOM.

Budget Hearing May 17

The Board approved the proposition to hold the FY18 Amended Budget Hearing on May 17, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at 650 Academic Drive, Algonquin, Illinois in the Board Room. The amended budget will be on display according to 105ILCS 5/17-1 Annual Budget, conveniently available to public inspection for at least 30 days prior to final action thereon, starting April 15, 2018 available at the Reception Desk in the Administrative Building.
