

Informational Reports

The Board heard reports on the following:

- A presentation on the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), which replaced the No Child Left Behind Act. The 2017-18 school year was the first implementation year for ESSA in Illinois, with the first public reporting to occur via the Illinois School Report Card in October of 2018. *Online at <https://v3.boardbook.org/Public/PublicItemDownload.aspx?ik=43098600>.*
- A presentation on the ongoing CTE Department curriculum review, which will culminate in a full presentation and proposal in the fall. - Monthly revenue and expenditures, fiscal, HR, O&M, and legislative reports.
- The 6th-date enrollment report, indicating overall District enrollment at 9,336 preK-12.

Pending Actions

At its next Regular Meeting September 20, the Board will vote whether to approve:

- Payables: Purchase Orders at \$844,461.58; Imprest checks at \$93,041.13; and Disbursements issued at \$4,083,995.12
- Proposed fundraising contracts with Yankee Candle to benefit HHS Student Council (\$3,000) and Great Opportunities to benefit the Marlowe Music Program (\$8,000)
- A contract with Terry Awrey to serve as a hearing officer at a rate of \$500 per case, and contracts with two mentors for the new principals at Marlowe and HHS.
- A memorandum of understanding with the HEA to dictate terms of strategic plan target bonuses given the adjusted timeline for indicators approved by the Board
- A change order to the Malcor Roofing contract for Marlowe roofing in the amount of \$1,715.00
- A change order to the Weatherguard Roofing contract for roofing at Conley and Mackeben, resulting in a credit to the District in the amount of \$17,656
- Minutes of the Board's July 19 Regular Meeting, August 2 Committee of the Whole, and August 16 Regular Meeting.
