Addendum No. 4 Items

1. Points of clarification
 - a. Grounds Services contractor shall provide Aeration as specific in general turf areas on all three campus properties. In addition they will provide aeration in all athletic fields at the Middle schools except the baseball diamonds
 - b. All athletic at Huntley High School and the baseball diamonds only at the Middle Schools are not included in the scope of services with the grounds management services contract
 - c. As a part of the annual service contract price, the contractor shall provide an Athletic Fields care worker to report to the District's ground management worker at Huntley high for 6 hours per day (M-F) for the duration of the contract duration period; March 15 thru November 15. Any hours worked beyond the allotted 6 hours per day is billed on a Time and Material basis at the rate provided in the unit price stated in the proposal.
 - d. The unit price for pond vegetation removal includes a one-time clearing of all vegetation in the wet and dry areas of all designated detention and retention ponds. However and annual price for grounds management services includes only ongoing maintenance of the dry areas as called for in the specifications.
 - e. The grounds management services contractor shall provide all bed mulch for trees and shrubs as a part of the annual contract price.
 - f. The grounds management services contractor shall provide all labor and equipment only as a part of the annual contract price for installation of the wood chip safety surface material from the central stock pile on each campus. The School District will procure that wood chip material for the playground safety surfaces each season.
 - g. For tree and shrub pruning, the School District requires a contract worker who has successfully completed the Ill. Department of Agriculture tree and shrub management coursework for clearing up ensuring pedestrian clearance, suckers and limb care under 15 ft. The individual need not be a "arborist".

2. Over seeding as called for on page 22 is require once per year, immediately following the annual aeration as a part of the proposal price using a broadcast spreader
