DEL CASTILLO NAMED ASSISTANT SUPT. FOR SPECIAL SERVICES

Dr. Rocio Del Castillo, who currently serves as director of curriculum for bilingual programs, will begin a new role July 1 as assistant superintendent for special services.

The position will provide high-level leadership for special education services, bilingual education/dual language, social-emotional learning, and educational equity.

In her current role, she leads our Dual Language program, which launched in 2018 with classrooms in our three kindergarten buildings, and educational equity.

Prior to joining Huntley 158, she oversaw a large dual language program in West Chicago Elementary School District 33 as coordinator for second language learners and previously served as principal of St. Joseph School.

This new position was developed based on the District's evolving needs and fills a vacancy at the cabinet level open since the retirement of Associate Superintendent Terry Awrey after the 2017-18 school year.
