DISTRICT PRESENTS SECONDARY (6-12) HYBRID LEARNING PLAN

Superintendent Scott Rowe presented a hybrid learning plan for students in middle and high school. The plan calls for students in grades 6-12 to have the option to remain in Remote Learning OR to attend in person for full days, two days a week (M/T or Th/F), every other week. In addition:

- Plan allows for high fidelity to public health guidelines
- Maintains current block schedule
- In-person students will be divided into four groups:
 - Group A in-person full day on Monday & Tuesday Week 1
 - Group B in-person full day on Thursday & Friday Week 1
 - Group C in-person full day on Monday & Tuesday Week 2
 - Group D in-person full day on Thursday & Friday Week 2
 - ALL students will be fully remote on Wednesdays
- Siblings within the same school will be placed to attend on same days
- Selections will be maintained for the length of the hybrid period.
 - Requests to switch from Hybrid to Remote can be accommodated by contacting your building administrator.
 - Requests to switch from Remote to Hybrid will be reviewed by your building administrator and accommodated if possible at the start of the next grading period
- Special education and targeted groups eligible for expanded attendance
