The Board recognized two donations:

- Louis Padula donated Zebco, Shimano, and Diawa fishing rods and reels for use of members of the HHS Fishing Club, valued at \$235.
- Ron Jensen donated two engines for Small Gas Engines Class at Huntley High School, valued at \$784.

Registration Fees Approved

The Board approved changes to registration fees, resulting in a new flat fee of \$155 per students in kindergarten through eighth grade. The flat fee includes a \$12 device protection fee and amounts to a decrease over last year's fees for kindergarten and middle school families and an increase of \$32 for first-through fifth-grade families.

- Handbooks for elementary, middle, and high schools for 2015-2016, as presented
- Purchase orders at \$354,363.91; Imprest checks at \$104,998.99; and disbursements issued at \$6,457,058.08, as presented
- Supplemental Purchase Orders at \$9,020,051.57 and Supplemental Accounts Payable at \$15,138.82
- The acquisition of a new 2015 Ford Transit 250 XL LR cargo Van at a price of \$23,875.00, reflecting a trade-in value of \$500 of the District's old cargo van
- Change orders totaling \$49,901.00 to contractors for high school renovations and additions projects
- Contracts as presented at the previous Committee of the Whole:
 - Performance Services Inc. for Guaranteed Energy Savings
 - Three-year service agreement with Honeywell for service to security systems
 - Bid #2015-45 for track surfacing to Midwest Track Builders, in the amount of \$58,207.00
 - Amended contract with Alpha Building Maintenance, including a two-year extension of the contract term and costs for increased manpower in FY16 and FY17
 - Oil and Grease Limited Maintenance Agreement with Suburban Elevator
 - Base Bid for the Floor Finish Replacement Bid #2015-29 to Johnson Floor Company at a total cost of \$27,875.00
- Minutes of the Board's March 19 regular meeting, April 2 Committee of the Whole, and closed session minutes of the March 19 meeting
- HR personal and addendum reports, and job descriptions for RTI positions created from restructuring current reading staff.
